The guy's on RIPCORN received a lot of fire and those last few days. You are all hero's who are only now really being recognized for your contributions. I remember you and the 2nd Platoon very well. **All of the Charlie Company men were a very special group of soldiers!!!**

I am still heavily engaged... too engaged for a retired guy... in support of DOD and our troops. I am one of DOD's senior mentors who support training exercises and operations world wide. I also spend a lot of time in Korea every year.
